## Scout Basic Course

(Check-in Instructions)

Follow the below check-in instructions and call Scout Course office at (910) 449-0472 during business hours or the SNCOIC (608-769-6334) if you require additional assistance.

All students are required to check in at Advanced Infantry Training Battalion (Bldg G483, Scout Course Classroom Rm 1010) at <u>1000</u> on the Course Report Date (not Convene Date). Arrive wearing Woodland MARPAT with 8-point covers.

The Report Day will be administrative, and students will assist the staff making final preparations for TD-1. Students will be billeted in the Squad Bay and are expected to reside there during the work week (unless married).

Students will be expected to run an Initial Performance Assessment (IPA) on TD-1 in lieu of a PFT. Be prepared to ruck and conduct 1000 level tasks.

\*Flacks and Kevlar will be packed in main ruck and will count towards the mandatory 45 lb dry weight. Glow belt will be secured around the pack. There is no associated gear list for this event. Rucks will be weighed prior to the event. A scale will be available for student use inside the classroom. Students will need to bring their own sling for this event.

All of your check-in paperwork will be thoroughly screened by the SNCOIC and Course Chief. Below are the required documents needed:

- 1. Orders
- 2. Command Screen Checklist
- 3. BIR/BTR
- 4. A pen to fill out paperwork.
